

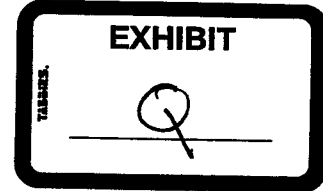

This case came before the Court on June 12, 2001.

Defendant's motion for change of Custody and additional summer visitation will be heard on July 17, 2001 from 8:15 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Defendant's motion for Contempt filed March 27, 2001 will be heard at the same time.

Plaintiff's motion of May 11, 2001 for contempt for failure to pay child support and Attorneys fees has not yet been set for hearing.

Mr. Cook has not had psychological testing.

Mr. Cook attempted to set an appointment for said testing, but was told by that office that due to non-payment for the services rendered, Mr. Cook would not be seen.

Defendant shall have until March 1, 2002 to make financial arrangements for Defendant's payment of said psychological testing.

Counsel for Defendant shall advise Counsel for Plaintiff that the financial arrangements are in place. Counsel for Plaintiff shall contact Mr. Cook to have Mr. Cook make an appointment for said psychological testing. In the event that no financial arrangements have been made by Defendant by March 1, 2002, the hearing will proceed without said psychological hearing. If Plaintiff wishes to introduce a Psychological report with respect to Mr. Cook, and Defendant has failed to make arrangements for payment of same, then Plaintiff make obtain a report at her own expense.

The Request for an in Camera interview of the children is sustained. This will occur at the beginning of the evidentiary hearing scheduled supra.

Plaintiff wishes to file a motion for Contempt of Court for failure to pay current child support. If said motion is filed prior to March 1, 2001, it will be heard at the evidentiary hearing scheduled supra.


Defendant wishes to amend his Contempt of Court motion, to a motion to determine whether or not certain debts were able to be discharged under Plaintiff's bankruptcy filings. If said motion is filed prior to March 1, 2001, it will be heard at the evidentiary hearing scheduled supra. Both Counsel shall submit briefs on the legal issues involved with respect to the concurrent jurisdiction at least seven days prior to trial.

Both parties shall submit a proposed findings of facts fourteen days prior to the hearing. The Magistrate can then identify the areas of disagreement, and confine the testimony to those areas.

There have been a myriad of motions filed in this case. The Magistrate notes that related issues are under objection, others are in the Court of Appeals, Criminal Court, and Federal Court. Counsel for Plaintiff and Counsel for Defendant shall file with this Court notice of any issues that are before this Magistrate within thirty (30) days of the journalization of this Entry.

In addition Counsel for Plaintiff and Counsel for Defendant shall file with this Court notice of any issues that are stayed because of collateral action before the other jurisdictions mentioned above. Said notice shall be filed within thirty (30) days of the journalization of this Entry.

Due to the consent of James Cook, who resides with the children to participating in the psychological testing, it may not be necessary to have Mr. Cook joined as a party. Counsel are directed to advise the Court with respect to this issue within thirty (30) days of the journalization of this Entry.

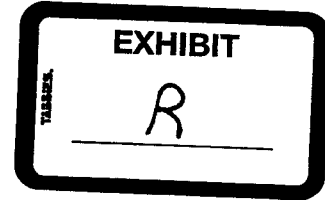
